History of Mediterranean Neonates*], 1 on *Developmental Nephrology: from embryology to metabolomics*, 1 on *Kidney Development in Renal Pathology*. His last book *Metabolomica e Microbiomica: la Medicina individualizzata dal feto all'adulto* is now in press in English by Academic Press, Elsevier: *Metabolomics and microbiomics: individualized medicine from the fetus to the adult*).
